When inquiring if your vault has been pre-buried ask for documentation proving the burial vault is still warranted.
- 5.) Funeral Homes in West Virginia are required by the Attorney General's Office to securely invest pre-planning funds and register the pre-need with their office. You and your family are protected by pre-planning with a funeral home. **ALWAYS** consult with a licensed funeral director prior making any funeral, cremation or cemetery related decisions.
